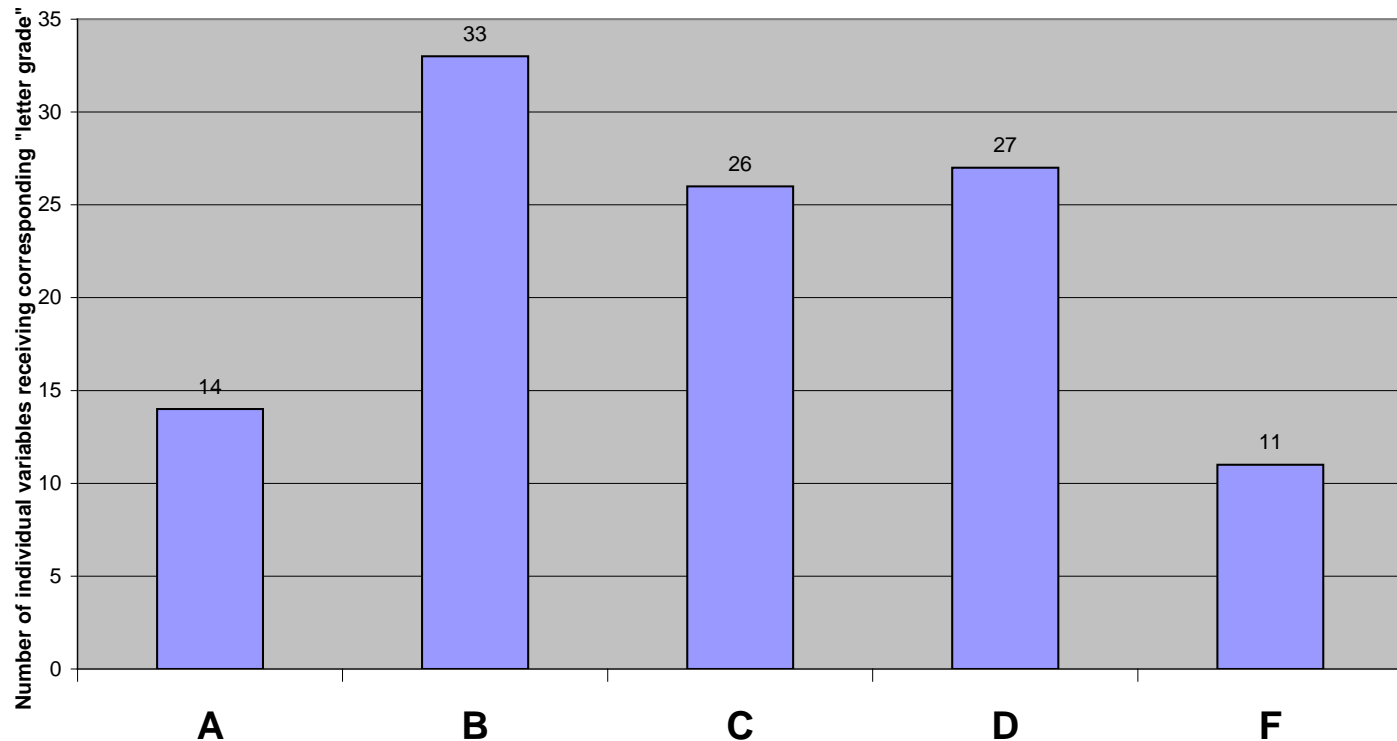

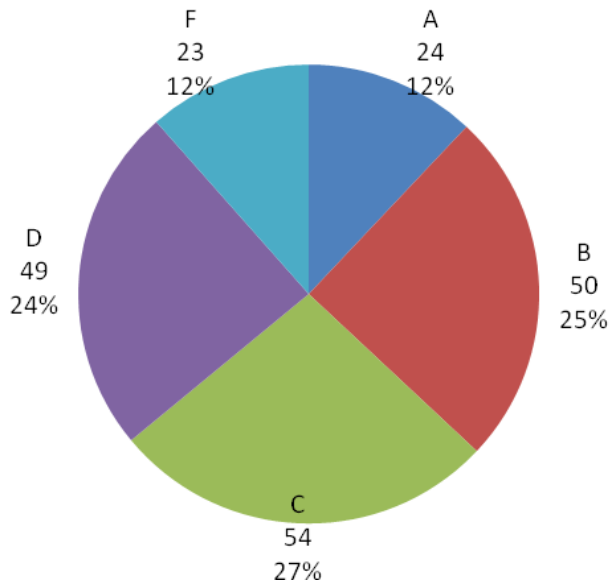

PA Compared to Other States

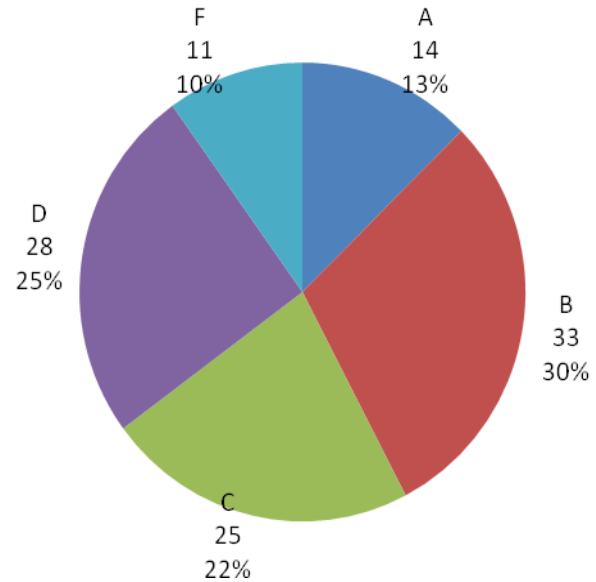
2010 Distribution of Pennsylvania's "Letter Grades" on 111 Factors of Competitiveness



Distribution of PA's “Letter Grades”

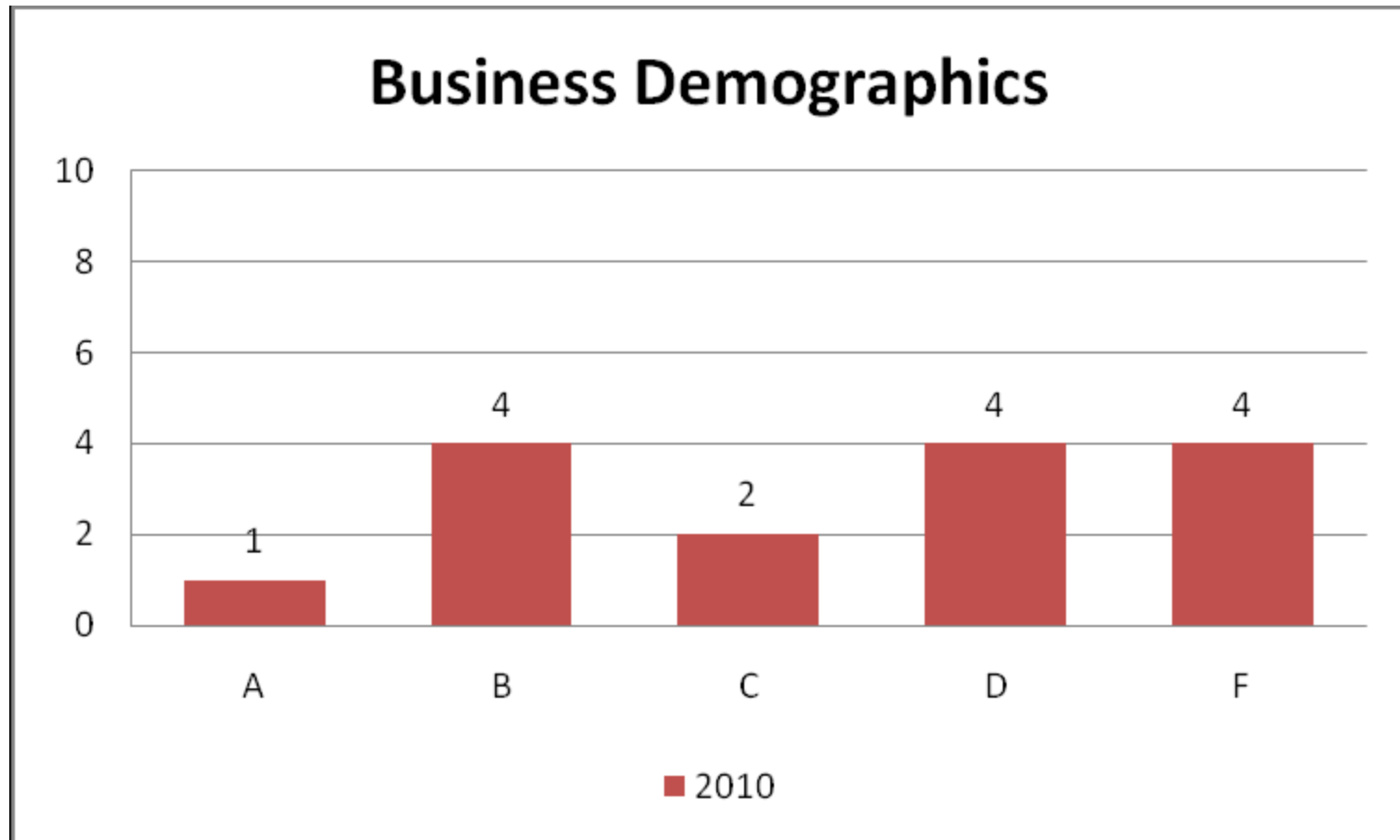

Limitations of Current Studies

- Measures not under our control
 - Availability of studies varies
 - Measures within studies may change over time
 - Indices created from raw data can be “black box”
- Studies may not reflect information decision-makers use or need

- Provide relevant and timely data.



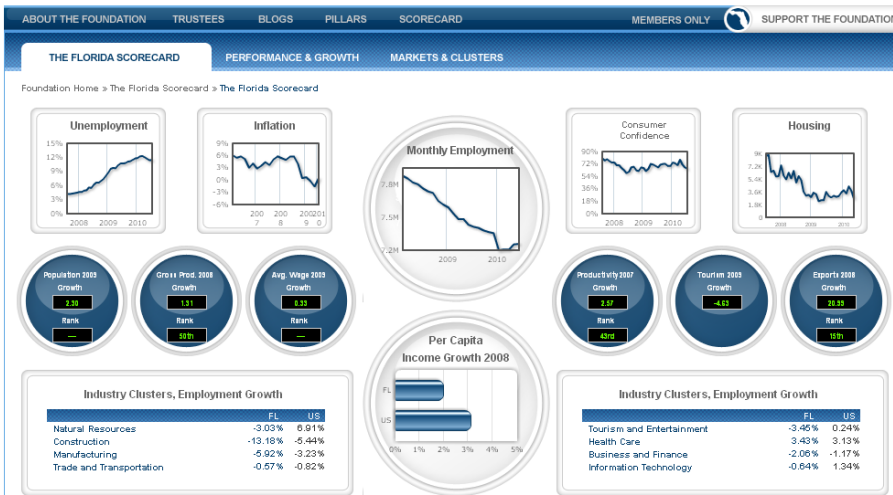

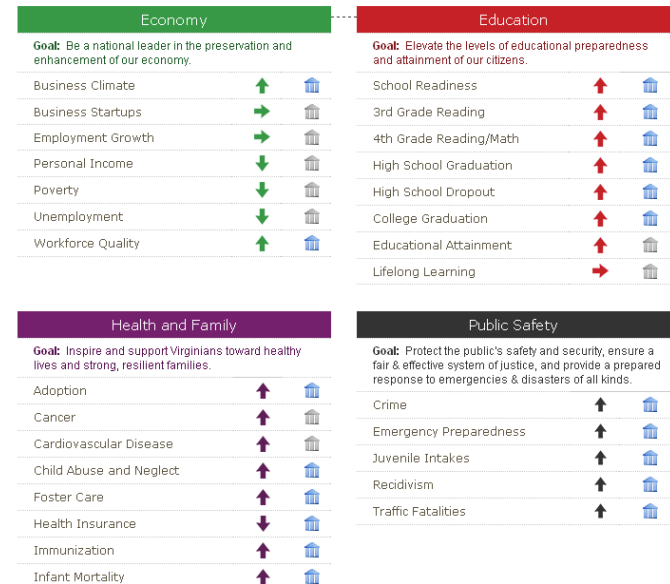
